



New York Notary Commission Process

Step-by-Step Instructions to Begin My Notary Commission

□ Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and are in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older
- Reside in NY or maintain business office in NY
- Good moral character
- Have the equivalent of "common school education"
- Not been convicted of a crime unless the Secretary of State finds that the crime committed doesn't bar you from commission

Step 2

I purchase state-required Notary journal at <u>NationalNotary.org/NY/Become</u> or called 1-800-876-6827. The NNA[®] will immediately ship the supplies that are not dependent upon the commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

□ Step 3

I contacted the <u>NY Department of State Division of Licensing Services</u> for information on taking the written examination, including the current schedule and exam locations.

□ Step 4

Upon passing the one-hour NYS Notary Public Examination, I was mailed a test "pass slip" that I submitted with my application.

□ Step 5

I have downloaded the Oath of office form and had it notarized.

□ Step 6

I created an <u>NY Business Express account</u> to complete and submit my Notary Public application. I included my notarized oath form, the state application fee, and my exam "pass slip".

Step 7

Upon approval of my commission, I received my commission ID card from the state.

Step 8

(If Notary stamp was purchased) I scanned and emailed a copy of my commission ID card, along with my NNA ID to <u>Releasing@NationalNotary.org</u> or faxed it to 1-800-833-1211.

□ Step 9

After my documents were received, my stamp was shipped within 3-5 business days.

NOTE: Any <u>New York Notary package</u> you purchase from the NNA will include your state required item: Notary journal. It's the best and most convenient way to make sure you have everything you need to become a New York Notary.
