☐ Step 1

I am eligible to become a Notary and am in compliance with state requirements:

- 18 years or older
- Am a citizen or permanent legal resident of the United States, and a resident of or have a place of employment or practice within KY
- Read and write English
- Am of good moral character
- No felony convictions unless civil rights have been restored
- Am capable of performing duties of Notary

☐ Step 2

I purchased my state-required Notary seal and supplies at www.NationalNotary.org/KY/Renew or I called 1-800-876-6827.

☐ Step 3

I have received the supplies that are not dependent upon my commission (e.g. journal, law primer, etc.).

☐ Step 4

I completed my commission application

☐ Step 5

I have received an email notice from the Secretary of State's office advising me to obtain a bond.

☐ Step 6

I have forwarded my email notice to the NNA to issue my bond: <u>Releasing@nationalnotary.org</u> or called 1-800-876-6827. The bond will be sent via email.

☐ Step 7

Within 30 days, I have gone to the county clerk's office (listed in my email) and taken my oath of office, posted my bond, and recorded my appointment date.

☐ Step 8

I have sent a copy of my commission certificate to the NNA: Releasing@nationalnotary.org, or faxed to 1-800-833-1211. Once my documents have been received, my stamp will be shipped within 3 business days.

☐ Step 9

I have received my seal stamp.
